HWMS visitor information

- Please secure all open loads with a tarp or rope.
- Customers are expected to sort their loads by material type. Please pre-sort loads prior to delivery to the HWMS for quick and easy unloading.
- Remove all fluids (gas, oil, etc.) from gas powered equipment such as lawnmowers.
- Oil drums and tanks must be empty and cut in half.
- Residential concrete/asphalt with rebar or wire mesh cannot be accepted for recycling. These items are accepted as garbage at the tipping fee of \$165/tonne.
- For health and safety reasons, Container Station Attendants are not permitted to assist customers with the unloading of materials. **Pre-arrange assistance to help unload heavy material, if needed.**

Paint and Stain Reuse Depot

Drop-off or pick-up usable paint and stain at the Paint & Stain Reuse Depot conveniently located beside the Household Hazardous Waste Depot at the HWMS. The Paint & Stain Reuse Depot is open from spring to fall. The HWMS cannot guarantee the availability of colours or quantities.

- Orange Boxes are free of charge and are limited to one per household.
- Orange boxes are used to collect, store, and transport your household hazardous waste to the HWMS Household Hazardous Waste Depot or on Special Waste Drop-off Days.
- **There is no curbside collection for the orange box.**



Backyard composters

- Pick up a backyard composter at the Halton Waste Management Site.
- Composters are \$15 each and are limited to two per household.
