

Put Waste In Its Place

Use our "Put Waste In Its Place" online tool at halton.ca/putwasteinitsplace. Enter an item and it will tell you how to reuse, recycle or dispose of it properly.



✓ Blue Box acceptable items



Disposable, rigid, plastic packaging and containers – no film, foil or caps



Single use plastic plates, cups and coffee cup lids – no cutlery



Plastic plant pots and trays



Boxed beverage containers
Tetra Paks®, milk and juice cartons



Aluminum foil, trays, metal food and beverage cans



Glass bottles and jars



Cardboard cans



Boxboard – flattened cereal, detergent and tissue boxes, etc. (liners go in garbage)



Newspapers, flyers, fine paper, magazines and books, envelopes (including plastic windows)



Corrugated cardboard
Tie in bundles no larger than 120 cm x 120 cm x 30 cm (4 ft x 4 ft x 1 ft)

✓ Green Cart acceptable items



All food waste including fruits and vegetables, candy, shells, meat and bones, dairy, baked goods, fats, oils and sauces, etc.



Paper products: paper rolls, paper egg cartons, paper plates and cups, paper towels and tissues, paper bags, paper frozen dinner trays, coffee filters.

Other items: dryer lint, feathers, hair, houseplants, wooden popsicle sticks, wooden chopsticks, sawdust and wood ashes (in paper bags), shredded paper.

✗ **Remember:** No plastic, glass, metal, Styrofoam, gum, stickers, elastics, pet waste or diapers.

Garbage items



Plastic cutlery, straws and bottle caps



Plastic wrap, bags, and film



Box liner bags e.g., cereal bags



Snack bags, wrappers and cookie bags



Gift wrap, ribbons and bows



Styrofoam



Pet waste and cat litter



Diapers
