6.	<i>Fail to have Cross Connection Survey completed by an Authorized Tester</i>	s. 27.1	\$500.00
7.	<i>Use equipment to test Backflow Prevention Device not verified or calibrated by an Authorized Tester</i>	s. 29.3	\$500.00
8.	<i>Perform function on Backflow Prevention Device, licencing and equipment not in good standing</i>	s. 29.4	\$1,000.00
9.	<i>Hinder, obstruct, refuse entry or interrupt the Region, Regional Employee, etc. in the exercise of any of the powers under the By-Law</i>	s. 35.1.i	\$500.00
10.	<i>Run water from the Drinking Water System waste or useless</i>	s. 35.1.ii	\$200.00

11.	<i>Alter, remove or bypass any Backflow Prevention Device or Regional Water Meter</i>	s. 35.1.iii	\$500.00
12.	<i>Open, close or obstruct access to any Hydrant, Valve or chamber</i>	s. 35.1.v	\$500.00
13.	<i>Obstruct access by Regional Employee to any part of the Drinking Water System</i>	s. 35.1.vi	\$500.00
14.	<i>Alter Regional Water Meter to lessen or alter the amount of water consumption registered</i>	s. 35.1.viii	\$1,000.00
15.	<i>Place material which obstructs access to Hydrant</i>	s. 35.1.x	\$200.00
16.	<i>Use water contrary to water use prohibition or restriction</i>	s. 35.1.xi	\$225.00
17.	<i>Hinder or obstruct an Officer</i>	s. 37.3	\$500.00
