### Introduction

#### Halton: A Snapshot



Halton Region is a vibrant community to more than 624,000 residents and four distinct communities. Recognized for its high quality of life and close proximity to Lake Ontario and the Niagara Escarpment, Halton Region is committed to ensuring the future is strong and stable.

The *Provincial Places to Grow Act* mandates that Halton Region’s population grow to approximately 1.1 million by the year 2051. Planning for this growth to create complete, active, healthy communities served by high-quality infrastructure, includes community services such as schools, which are a high priority for the Region.

The below School Board capital needs are integral to building complete communities in Halton.
