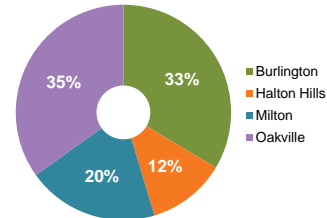

### Municipal Distribution of Labour 2016 <sup>3</sup>



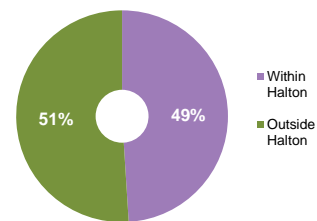
