RE: Starting July 6, you can choose how to get your vaccines – pick up or courier

QUICK FACTS

- Starting **July 6, 2023**, healthcare providers can choose to either:
 - Continue having vaccines couriered to their facility at their expense, or
 - Pick up vaccines at the Halton Regional Centre at 1151 Bronte Road in Oakville on Tuesdays (9:00 a.m. -11:30 a.m.) and Wednesdays (9:00 a.m. – 1:30 p.m.).
- To choose the courier option:
 - Facilities must set up an account with a vaccine courier service.
 - To set up an account with Critical Path, facilities must complete an [Account Activation Form](#) and email it to ar@criticalpath.ca.
 - If you have questions about the account setup process, contact Critical Path at ar@criticalpath.ca or 905-212- 8333.
- To choose the pick-up option:
 - Facilities must select their pick-up day when placing their [vaccine order](#) online.
 - Pick-up will be available on Tuesdays between 9:00 a.m. - 11:30 a.m. and Wednesdays between 9:00 a.m. – 1:30 p.m.
 - Pick-up windows will alternate bi-weekly according to the municipality.
- Dates for when vaccine pick-ups will resume is dependent on the completion of construction at 1151 Bronte Road in Oakville. Therefore, dates may change if there are unanticipated delays.
- Please refer to the attached vaccine distribution schedule for order, delivery and pick-up dates for your municipality.
