RE: Vaccine Ordering Deadlines for Holiday Closure and Ordering School-Based Vaccines

QUICK FACTS

- Halton Region's administrative offices will be closed from Tuesday, December 24, 2024, to Wednesday, January 1, 2025, and will reopen on Thursday, January 2, 2025.
- Vaccine distribution will be unavailable during the closure.
- Refer to the order cut-off dates and distribution schedule below to ensure your facility receives vaccines before the holiday closure.
- Starting November 28, 2024, all school-based vaccine orders will transition to the new ordering process that has been in place since June 2024.
- Clinics can order Men-C-ACYW-135, Hepatitis B, and HPV-9, for students in grades 7-12 by faxing a completed Vaccine Order & Reporting Form for School-Based Vaccines to 905-465-3403.
- Single physician practices can order up to 5 doses of each school-based vaccine. Larger practices with multiple physicians or single physician practices that regularly administer Men-C-ACYW-135, Hepatitis B, and/or HPV-9 vaccines under the routine vaccine program can order up to 20 doses of each school-based vaccine.

Changes to Process for Ordering School-Based Vaccines

- Starting November 28, 2024, orders for the Men-C-ACYW-135, Hepatitis B, and HPV-9 vaccines, which are to be administered to students in grades 7-12 as part of the routine vaccination program, must be submitted by faxing a completed Vaccines to 905-465-3403.
- For doses administered under the high-risk vaccine program, continue to place orders through the <u>online vaccine ordering form</u> as a high-risk vaccine order. Refer to the <u>Publicly Funded</u> <u>Immunization Schedule for Ontario, Tables 2 and 3</u>, for eligibility criteria for routine and highrisk vaccine programs.
- Clinics may administer existing doses of school-based vaccines currently in their vaccine
 fridges to eligible individuals. There is no need to call Public Health to have these vaccines
 allocated to another patient.
- All school-based vaccines can be ordered as single doses. Ensure that you have no more than
 a one-month supply when placing your order.
- If you have not submitted a vaccine order through the online vaccine order form within the same ordering cycle, a temperature log for the most 30 recent days must be included with your school-based vaccine order.
- Clinics should continue to order school-based vaccines by the Wednesday before their next scheduled bi-weekly delivery date, following the existing <u>Vaccine Distribution Schedule.</u>
- Parents or guardians are still responsible for reporting all their child's immunizations to Public Health, including any school-based vaccines not given by Public Health, at halton.ca/immunize.
