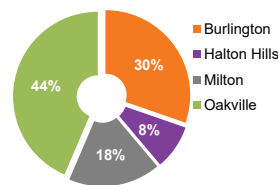

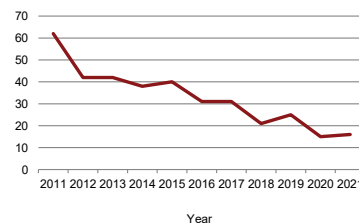
## 2021 Distribution of Establishments<sup>1</sup>
