



**NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING**  
**DEVELOPMENT CHARGE BY-LAW**

In February 2021, Halton Region began a consultation process for the 2022 development charges update. A Background Study has been prepared to propose a by-law that will replace the Region's existing residential and non-residential water, wastewater (Built Boundary and Greenfield Areas), roads and general services development charges in By-law No. 36-17.

The "2022 Halton Development Charges Background Study" for the Region's Development Charges By-law was made available to the public on **Wednesday December 15, 2021**, and can be obtained through the Office of the Regional Clerk at 1151 Bronte Road, Oakville, Ontario, L6M 3L1. The Study is available on the Development Charges webpage on [halton.ca](http://halton.ca). If you wish to view a hard copy of the Background Study in person, please make an appointment (please see the below emails) as COVID-19 protocols must be observed.

***Public Meeting***

The *Development Charges Act, 1997* requires that at least one public meeting be held prior to the passing of a development charges by-law. The purpose of this public meeting is to present the 2022 Halton Development Charges Background Study and proposed by-law and to allow persons to make representations relating to the proposed by-law.

The public meeting will be held by the Regional Council as follows:

All interested persons are invited to participate in the public meeting and to make representations. Interested persons should note that the development charge proposals might change as a result of the meeting and any further staff reports.

The final by-law will be presented to Council for approval on **Wednesday, April 20, 2022, at 9:30 a.m. via Zoom Video Conference.**
